Bluebonnet Baptist Association  
165th Annual Meeting Minutes  
October 9, 2023

The annual meeting was held at the campus of First Baptist Church, Blanco, Texas.

Moderator, John Minton, Pastor of Everyday Christian Fellowship Church, Cibolo, Texas called the meeting to order, welcomed everyone, and presented a motion to amend the Order of Business as printed in the 2023 BBA program due to the illness of Church Planting Consultant, Pastor Dustin Wooten. A motion was made to accept the change and adopt the Order of Business as written, seconded and approved without question or dissent.

Gary Kuzins, Associate Pastor/Youth Pastor of First Baptist Church Blanco, welcomed everyone, read Scripture from Colossians 3:12 and led in prayer.

Congregational singing was led by the First Baptist Church Blanco Music Team.

Executive Director of the Association, Dr. Robby Partain, presented his annual report. His written report is found on pages 10 and 11 of the 2023 Annual Book of Reports. He gave an update on the new ministry that began in 2022 called the "Intern Partnership Plan". Dr. Partain was approached with a question from Pastor Brad Mills of Central Baptist Church Luling concerning the amendment to the BBA Constitution which will be addressed later in the meeting. His oral report is attached as an addendum to these minutes.

Dr. J. K. Minton, Church Health Consultant for the Association, presented his annual report. His written report is found on page 12 of the 2023 Book of Reports.

The Administrative Team Report, Part 1 was presented by Paul Brand, Chair and Pastor of Bulverde Baptist Church, Bulverde, Texas. His report contained the following:

- The Year-to-Date Financial Report of the Association ending on September 30, 2023, is found on page 15 of the 2023 Book of Reports. Motion was made to accept the financial report as presented. There were no questions, and the report was approved without dissent.
- The proposed Annual Budget for 2024 is found on page 16 of the 2023 Book of Reports. A motion was made to accept the 2024 Annual Budget as written and it was approved without dissent.
- First Lockhart Baptist Church petition to join BBA. All in attendance voted to accept this petition.
- The 2023 Administrative Team Minutes are found on page 13-14 of the 2023 Book of Reports.

The Mission Coordinating Team Report was presented by John Molina, Chair and Interim Pastor of Westside Baptist Church, Seguin, Texas. A motion was made to adopt the 2023-2024 Nominees for Officers and Team Members as printed on page 19 of the 2023 Book of Reports. The motion passed without question or dissent.

Congregational Singing was led by the First Baptist Church Blanco Music Team.

The Administrative Team Report, Part 2 was presented by Paul Brand, Chair and Pastor of Bulverde Baptist Church, Bulverde, Texas. A motion from the Administrative Team to Amend “Article II – Definition” of the BBA Constitution was presented. If the motion is approved by a two-thirds vote of the messengers, the amended Article II will read (with new text shown here in italics):

*“The Association is a voluntary alliance of independent, autonomous, Southern Baptist churches and other churches whose doctrine and practice are consistent with the Association’s statement of faith and core values cooperating with one another in accordance with the articles of this Constitution.”*

\_\_\_\_\_ Yes, I am in favor of this motion to amend Article II.

\_\_\_\_\_ No, I am opposed to this motion to amend Article II.

Dr. Robby Partain explained the motion before giving the floor to those who spoke “For” and those who spoke “Against” the motion. After the discussions, the messengers voted by written ballots and the ballots were collected by Jacob Connor, Pastor of First Baptist Church, Canyon Lake, Texas, and his ballot collection and counting team. The final count will be presented later in the meeting.

Vice-Moderator, Keith Maddox, proposed that the 2024 Annual Meeting of the Association be held on Monday, October 14, 2024, at the site of Oakwood Church, New Braunfels, Texas. The preacher for the annual sermon will be Ray Still, Pastor of Oakwood Church, New Braunfels. The proposal was seconded and approved unanimously by the messengers.

The congregational singing was again led by the First Baptist Church Blanco Music Team.

The annual sermon was presented by David Mathis, Pastor of Hope Church Kyle. He entitled his sermon message; “How is your relationship with Jesus”. He quoted many references from the Word of God.

Jacob Conner, Pastor of the First Baptist Church, Canyon Lake, Texas gave a report of the counting of the ballots. There were 89 votes cast, 62 votes “For” and 27 votes “Against” the motion to amend Article II of the BBA Constitution. The motion was approved with 69.6% of the votes for the amendment.

The congregation was then led by the First Baptist Church Blanco Music Team in a closing song.

## Executive Director's Oral Report

My written annual report is contained in your Book of Reports. I'll make this oral report brief as we have other business to address today.

In 2022 we began piloting the Intern Partnership Plan, a collaboration between the association and local churches to create "on ramps" for emerging ministry leaders. At the beginning of 2023 we officially rolled it out. To date we've initiated eight internships in partnership with local churches. Three of those internships have finished and five are still in progress. It's been a diverse group so far – three church planting interns, two pastoral interns, and one each in worship, creative arts and student ministry. Three of the internships have been internal placements, meaning the interns are serving in churches they were already a part of. Five have been external placements, where the association has played the role of matching an intern applicant with a supervising church.

I'm encouraged, and frankly surprised, about how quickly this ministry has taken off. I'm still on a learning curve with it. With each internship I'm gaining a little more insight into what works and what doesn't work and how best to assist the supervising churches and their interns. I'm also looking down the road at the possibility of working with some of our colleges and seminaries, potentially matching some of their students with BBA churches for an internship experience.

As we prepare for 2024, I'm ready to accept more intern applicants and partner with more supervising churches. If your church is interested and/or you have someone in your church who senses a call from the Lord and needs a place to get hands-on, mentored experience in the local church setting, I look forward to hearing from you and seeing how we might collaborate together.

I ask your continued prayers for our brother, Dustin Wooten, as he recovers from a still-unexplained outbreak of blood clots throughout his body. Dustin has done an excellent job as our newest staff member at BBA, serving in the role of Church Planting Consultant. As eager as I am for him to resume that role, I know his family and church are even more eager to have him back at full strength. Please pray for Dustin, his wife Kristen and son Soren, their extended family and their church family at New Day Church in Schertz. Thank you for doing so.

I also want to say thank you for allowing me to serve as your Executive Director. Susan and I are now in our sixteenth year with BBA and looking forward to more. You bless us with your prayers, your friendship, your kindness and your generosity. I count it a great gift to be entrusted with this ministry of assisting churches.

### Frequently Asked Questions about BBA and the Budget

1. *How is the association's budget formed?* BBA has an annual budget that reflects our mission of *assisting churches*. We budget on the calendar year. Around early August of each year, the Executive Director prepares a budget draft using current-year receipts to forecast the next year's receipts. The staff reviews all personnel, ministry, and administrative expenses and develops budget estimates for the next year based on projected receipts and ministry plans. The Executive Director then meets with the BBA Administrative Team to review the budget proposal and to make changes as needed. Once the Administrative Team approves, the budget is sent to all member churches in advance of the BBA annual meeting in October. The messengers at the annual meeting must give final approval.

2. *How is the budget funded?* The budget is funded primarily by contributions from BBA member churches. There is no set amount for church contributions. Most churches give a percentage of their undesignated tithes and offerings each month. Some churches give a set dollar amount each month or quarter. In addition to the contributing churches, there are some generous individuals who also contribute to the budget of the association. The bottom line is that BBA is a cooperative ministry. The association is funded primarily by the churches for the purpose of *assisting churches*.

3. *How is the budget structured?* An established church typically has 50 – 60% of its budget in the personnel category. The rest of the church budget is taken up with facilities, ministry, and administrative expenses. The BBA budget is structured differently because BBA is not a church. Similar to previous budgets, the 2024 budget proposal has 78% of funds in the personnel category, which includes salaries, housing allowances, employment taxes, medical and other insurance, retirement account contributions, and reimbursable expenses for our employees. The rest of the budget is split between ministry and administrative expenses.

4. *Why is BBA's budget structure so much different than a church's?* Remembering that our mission is *assisting churches*, BBA does not usurp the primary place of the local church in ministering to the community. We do not operate large ongoing ministries as a church does (worship services, Sunday School, student ministry, music ministry, recreation programs, benevolence, outreach events, etc.). We also have low facilities costs. We exist to assist churches; the primary way we do that is through *staff time and expertise*. Our budget is structured to provide services to churches through associational staff and consultants. The specific ministries we budget for are also church assisting in nature: church planting, partnerships with local churches, and equipping church leaders.

5. *Are all the association's ministries paid for through the budget?* No, and this is another reason that our budget is weighted toward personnel. The association maintains designated accounts that allow us to go beyond our budget in assisting churches. These designated accounts are funded from past budget surpluses plus designated gifts from churches and individuals. These funds allow us to do more for churches in the areas of church planting, equipping and caring for ministry leaders, conferences and retreats, and partnering with churches in various ministries and missions endeavors. In addition, we have a Ministry and Maintenance Reserve designated account that ensures the association's ministry will continue uninterrupted in the case of a large, unforeseen event (such as a wide-scale weather event that disrupts receipts from churches, a large facilities expense like replacing the HVAC system, etc.).

We strive to be good stewards of the Lord's resources that are entrusted to us. We are audited by an independent CPA and our financial reports are public information. The budget is actively managed each year to make sure spending is in line with actual receipts.
